- Insert your activation card, arrow side up, in the card reader at the base of the tablet to activate your ballot. No voter information or ballot choices are stored on the activation card or the unit itself.
- Change the font size and screen contrast as needed.






- Font Size Contrast

MAIL-IN BALLOTS: All Active Voters of the two major political parties will be mailed a paper ballot around January 15th. You may vote this ballot, return it in the postage pre-paid envelope, return it in-person at a ballot drop-off location, or surrender it to vote in-person.

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED if you registered to vote by mail, did not provide an ID at the time of registering, or registered online after the deadline. Proof of identity and residence may be required before your ballot is counted.

ASSISTANCE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR VOTERS IF NEEDED. Ask an election worker for assistance:

- If you need help reading the ballot or operating the voting machine.
- If you think you have received an incorrect ballot style. Do not cast the ballot.

Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter requesting assistance at a polling place. (NRS 293.565(11)) Nevada residents with a disability can mark their ballot electronically by going to www.nvEASE.gov.

WARNING: A person who is entitled to vote shall not vote or attempt to vote more than once in the same election. Any person who votes or attempts to vote twice at the same election is guilty of a Category D Felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. (NRS 293.780)
