CALL TO ORDER

1. Call meeting to order.

The Liquor Board met pursuant to law on March 17, 2026 in the Commissioner's Chambers at the Eureka County Court House. Present were Chairman Marty Plaskett, Commissioner Mike Schoenwald, District Attorney Ted Beutel, Sheriff Miles Umina and Clerk Recorder Kathy Bowling. Vice Chair Rich McKay was absent. The meeting was called to order at 9:14 a.m. The interactive video conferencing system was connected between Crescent Valley and Eureka for the entire meeting.

LIQUOR BOARD AGENDA

1. Approval of agenda notice. **(For Possible Action)**

Commissioner Schoenwald motioned to approve the agenda, Sheriff Umina seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of minutes for the January 6, 2026, Liquor Board meeting. **(For Possible Action)**

Commissioner Schoenwald motioned to approve the January 6, 2026 Liquor Board meeting minutes, Sheriff Umina seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATIONS / QUARTERLY RENEWALS

1. Discuss, approve or deny new liquor license applications, including single event applications if any. *Note: A single event license is typically issued to a party licensed in another county, who wishes to serve/sell liquor at a specific event in Eureka County.* **(For Possible Action)**

Sheriff Umina reported there were no new license applications including single event applications.

No action was taken.

2. Report from Sheriff on issuance of any special event licenses approved for the quarter. *Note: A special event license allows a Eureka County license holder to serve/sell liquor at an event that takes place away from their normal place of business. (Discussion)*

Sheriff Umina reported no special event licenses were submitted.

3. Discuss, approve or deny liquor license quarterly renewals. **(For Possible Action)**

Sheriff Umina reported 2 quarterly renewals did not come in for the January 1st quarter, they have made multiple efforts to contact them with no success. They have gone around and talked directly with business owners about checking ID's.

Vice Chair Plaskett motioned to approve the liquor license quarterly renewals, Commissioner Schoenwald seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
