#### **CALL TO ORDER**

1. Call meeting to order.

The Liquor Board met pursuant to law on October 21, 2025 in the Commissioner's Chambers at the Eureka County Court House. Present was Chairman Marty Plaskett, Vice Chair Rich McKay, Assistant District Attorney Holli Else, Sheriff Miles Umina and County Clerk Recorder Kathy Bowling. Commissioner Mike Schoenwald was absent. The meeting was called to order at 9:16 a.m. The interactive video conferencing system was connected between Crescent Valley and Eureka for the entire meeting.

## LIQUOR BOARD AGENDA

1. Approval of agenda notice. (For Possible Action)

Commissioner McKay motioned to approve the agenda, Sheriff Umina seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Chairman Plaskett called for public comment in both Eureka and Crescent Valley, hearing none he proceeded to the next item.

## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of minutes for July 15, 2025 and October 7, 2025 Liquor Board meetings. (For Possible Action)

Commissioner McKay motioned to approve the July 15, 2025 and October 7, 2025 Liquor Board meeting minutes. Sheriff Umina seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

## LIQUOR CONTROL CODE

1. Discuss and consider action against Eleny Mentaberry, DBA The Owl Club, in violation of the Eureka County Liquor Control Code for (A) habitual delinquent license renewal, (Title 4, Chapter 30, Section .120) and for (B) allowing minors to Loiter in the bar area (Title 4, Chapter .240). (For Possible Action)

- (A) Sheriff Umina reported Eleny Mentaberry, doing business as The Owl Club, was late paying the quarterly fees for the second quarter on April 4<sup>th</sup>, the third quarter on July 8<sup>th</sup> and the last quarter on October 7<sup>th</sup>. He reported they charged her the 10% late fee, and she is all caught up on her fees.
- (B) Sheriff Umina reported an incident at The Owl Club on September 20<sup>th</sup> where minors were in the bar when an altercation occurred and resulted in a minor getting injured. Assistant District Attorney Holli Else suggested The Owl club start scanning ID's or manually writing them down so when a Sheriff Deputy comes in, they can check the list. Eleny Mentaberry explained the September 20<sup>th</sup> event was during the Wine Walk and people were in and out of The Owl Club, when it was noticed a minor was inside the staff had them wait in the restaurant for their parents. The Board discussed requiring a bouncer at the door when there are large parties or events happening in town. The Board discussed changing the county code to reflect the changes they discussed, they will hold a public hearing in December to discuss changes.

Sheriff Umina motioned to approve the Sheriff's Office sending out a letter to all liquor license holders making them aware of the 10% late fee after the 5<sup>th</sup> and to also notice them having a bouncer or bartenders scanning or recording IDs to every person during a large event. Chairman McKay seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
