# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **WHY DID I RECEIVE A MAIL BALLOT?**

With the passage of Assembly Bill 321 during the 2021 Legislative Session, all active registered voters in Eureka County will receive a ballot by mail. You may choose to vote using your mail ballot or vote in person using a voting machine. You can opt out of receiving future mail ballots by completing a Mail Ballot Preference Form and submitting it to the County Clerk Recorders Office. The form can be found at the Secretary of State's website: <https://www.nvsos.gov/elections/voters/mail-ballot-voting> or upon request from the Clerk Recorder's Office.

## **HOW DO I VOTE IN-PERSON USING A VOTING MACHINE?**

If you choose to vote in-person, please appear at a vote center during the specified dates and times. **Please bring the ballot that you received in the mail.** You will need to surrender this ballot to vote in-person. If you do not bring your mail ballot, you will be required to sign a voter affirmation that states that you will not vote twice in the election before being issued a ballot to cast in-person using a voting machine.

## **HOW DO I VOTE MY MAIL BALLOT?**

Instructions will be provided with your ballot. Mark your ballot and sign the return envelope. You may return your ballot by:

- Mail in the postage-paid envelope;
- Hand-deliver to a Eureka County polling location during polling hours; or
- Hand-deliver to the Clerk Recorder's Office during normal business hours.

**Your voted ballot must be postmarked by June 9, 2026, and received by the Clerk Recorder's Office by 5:00 p.m. on June 13, 2026. We recommend requesting hand cancellation at the Post Office and mailing your ballot seven (7) days before Election Day.**

**If you are hand-delivering your voted mail ballot, the ballot must be received by the Clerk Recorder's Office no later than 5:00 p.m. or at a polling location by 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, 2026.**

**REQUEST FOR REPLACEMENT BALLOTS:** All requests for replacement ballots received by 5:00 p.m., May 26, 2026, will be processed and mailed. After May 26, 2026, all replacement ballots must be picked up in person at the Clerk Recorder's office.

## **HOW DO I VOTE IF I AM UNABLE TO SIGN MY MAIL BALLOT DUE TO A LIMITING CONDITION OR I AM ELDERLY OR DISABLED?**

The Nevada Secretary of State's Office has a web-based solution if you are unable to sign your mail ballot, elderly, or disabled. Please visit [NVEASE.gov](http://NVEASE.gov) to find out more.

Upon a voter's request who is elderly or disabled, reasonable accommodations will be made to assist the voter at a polling location.

## **WHAT IF MY MAIL BALLOT ENVELOPE STATES "ID REQUIRED"?**

If you registered to vote by mail, or did not provide proof of identity at the time of registering, you may be required to provide proof of identity and residence with your ballot. Please contact the Clerk Recorder's Office at (775) 237-5263 with any questions.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## IMPORTANT ELECTION INFORMATION AND DATES

### WHO WILL BE ON MY PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT ?

Nevada conducts closed primary elections. Voters may only vote in a major party (Republican or Democrat) race if you are a registered voter of that party. This voter information and sample ballot list all offices and candidates that are on the 2026 Primary Election ballot. When voting, you may mark the choice “None of these Candidates” if you choose not to vote for any of the candidates for that office.

### WHAT ARE THE VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES?

May 12, 2026 Last day a person may register to vote by mail and by appearing in person at the Clerk Recorder's Office.

May 26, 2026 Last date to update your registration and be mailed a ballot

June 9, 2026 Last day a voter may register online at RegisterToVote.NV.gov

June 9, 2026 In-person registration for anyone with a valid and current Nevada Driver’s License, Identification Card or Tribal ID. Anyone appearing to register or update an existing voter registration must provide identification, and if applicable, proof of residency. New voters will receive a provisional ballot.

### WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS TO SAME DAY REGISTER TO VOTE IN NEVADA?

- Must present a valid Nevada Driver’s License, Identification Card or Tribal ID.
- Must be a citizen of the United States
- Must be 18 Years or older on or before Election Day
- Must have continuously resided within Eureka County since May 10, 2026, and in your current Precinct since May 30, 2026.

**NRS 293.780: Any person who votes or attempts to vote twice at the same Election is guilty of a category D Felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.**

Insert your activation card, arrow side up, in the card reader at the base of the tablet to activate your ballot. **No voter information or ballot choices are stored on the activation card or the unit itself.**

Change the font size and screen contrast as needed.

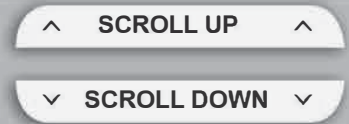

Tap your choice to vote. Tap the **Next** → button to advance to the next contest/question



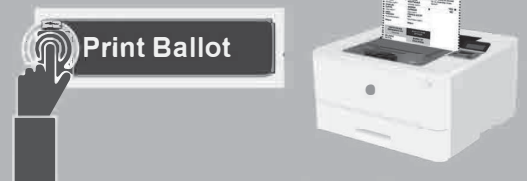

If there are more candidates than will fit on the screen, scroll through the candidate names by touching the “scroll up” or “scroll down” buttons

Once you are satisfied with your selections, tap “Print Ballot”.  
Warning: Allow the ballot to fully print on both sides before taking it out of the printer.

Place your printed ballot in the privacy sleeve, bring it to the ballot box and insert into the slot. Give the card and sleeve back to an Election Officer.
