CALL TO ORDER

1. Call meeting to order.

The Liquor Board met pursuant to law on October 7, 2025 in the Commissioner's Chambers at the Eureka County Court House. Present was Chairman Marty Plaskett, Vice Chair Rich McKay, Member Michael Schoenwald via Webex, District Attorney Ted Beutel, Sheriff Miles Umina and County Clerk Recorder Kathy Bowling. The meeting was called to order at 9:16 a.m.

LIQUOR BOARD AGENDA

1. Approval of agenda notice. **(For Possible Action)**

Commissioner McKay motioned to approve the agenda with the tabling of the July 15, 2025 meeting minutes; Commissioner Schoenwald seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT & DISCUSSION

1. Public comment and discussion. *NOTE: No action may be taken on an issue raised under public comment until the matter has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action will be taken.* **(Discussion)**

Chairman Plaskett called for public comment in both Eureka and Crescent Valley, hearing none he proceeded to the next item.

1. Approval of minutes for July 15, 2025, Liquor Board meeting. **(For Possible Action)**

LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATIONS / QUARTERLY RENEWALS

1. Discuss, approve or deny new liquor license applications, including single event applications if any. *Note: A single event license is typically issued to a party licensed in another county, who wishes to serve/sell liquor at a specific event in Eureka County.* **(For Possible Action)**

Sheriff Umina reported no single event licenses.

No action was taken.

2. Report from Sheriff on issuance of any special event licenses approved for the quarter. *Note: A special event license allows a Eureka County license holder to serve/sell liquor at an event that takes place away from their normal place of business. (Discussion)*

Sheriff Umina reported the Wine Walk that was held on September 20 had a special event license and the Car Show held a special event license under Ralf Cudas license. The Poker Run on October 11 and the Halloween ball on October 25 will have a special event license.

3. Discuss, approve or deny liquor license quarterly renewals. **(For Possible Action)**

Sheriff Umina reported issues they have been having with the Owl Club; during the Wine Walk there was an incident where juveniles were in and out of the bar and a juvenile was injured. The Owl Club is also consistently late in paying their liquor licenses, Sheriff Umina asked the board for direction on how they would like to handle the late licenses. District Attorney Beutel suggested a notice can be sent and the Board can hold another liquor board meeting at the next commission date to invite the licensee to discuss the situation.

Commissioner McKay motioned to approve holding a liquor board meeting at the next commission date to include delinquent quarterly renewal payment and to notify any delinquent applicants. Commissioner Schoenwald seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner McKay motioned to adjourn the meeting, Commissioner Schoenwald seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

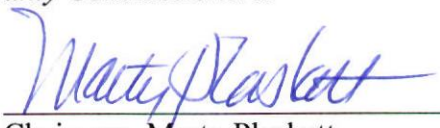
