Your voted ballot must be postmarked on or before November 3, 2026, and received by the Clerk Recorder's Office not later than 5 p.m. on the fourth day following the election (Saturday, November 7, 2026). Keep in mind that the USPS can take up to 7 or more days to process mail in Eureka County. To ensure your vote is counted, I strongly encourage voters to return ballots as early as possible. You may also consider using official ballot drop boxes or hand delivering your ballot to the Clerk Recorder's Office to avoid any potential delay.
