This is an invitation to bid on the Eureka County Fair bar services. Please use this invitation to submit your bid(s) and attach supplemental pages as necessary. Bids will be received for furnishing services according to these instructions and specifications. To be considered, this invitation to bid form must be completed in its entirety and **must be received no later than 5:00pm local time on April 14, 2023**. The bids discussed at the April 2023 Eureka County Fair Board Meeting. The decision to accept a bid will depend on the quality of the bid, not necessarily on the lowest bid price. If your bid is accepted, your bid constitutes a binding contract and includes the specifications of this invitation to bid.

Bid Specifications

- 1. Provide bar services for the 2023 Eureka County Fair to be held August 11-13, 2023.
- 2. Must offer a wide selection of prices and a variety of drinks. Please include your proposed drink menu including menu item prices.
- 3. The required hours of operation are as follows:

Thursday - Set- up

Friday - 11am - closing Saturday - 10am - closing

- 4. Vendor is responsible for set-up and take-down at the beginning and end of shifts.
- 5. Vendor will need to create bar area to be set up behind grandstands during the day and move to the pavilion on the evening of Saturday, August 12 during the dance.
- 6. Please specify types of drinks being served (No glass containers permitted).
- 7. Vendor must hold in good standing the required licenses and permits.
- 8. The submitted bid must be inclusive of all costs, and no additional reimbursement will be allowed for travel or other expenses.
- 9. Failure to perform allows the Fair Board to hire a replacement with the original contract holder responsible for any additional costs between the original contract and the cost incurred due to failure of performance.
- 10. Vendor is responsible for following all laws set forth by the county, state, and federal government regarding sales of alcohol.
- 11. Vendor is responsible for checking the ID of every customer and for serving alcohol only to persons over the age of 21.
- 12. Eureka County reserves the right to revoke your privileges to serve alcoholic beverages at fairground events.

- 13. There will be a **\$200.00** fee for the contract as Bar Vendor for the duration of the fair.
- 14. Bidders must accept and bids/contracts must include the following provision: *The parties understand and agree that, notwithstanding any other obligations or conditions or mandatory requirements in this contract, the parties will not demand performance or payment from each other if the federal government, Nevada state government, Eureka County government, or other proper authority cancels the Eureka County Fair as the result of the current COVID-19 pandemic. If this Fair event is cancelled in whole or in part, both parties understand and agree and by the execution of this contract hereby do release the other from all damages, claims, and assessments, including but not limited to demanding full or part performance, and agree to forego full or part payment, for any work already completed, and any work or performance contemplated.*
