BULL RIDING & SADDLE BRONC SHOW BID FORM

This is an invitation to bid to provide a Bull Riding and Saddle Bronc event at the Eureka County Fair on August 8, 2026.

Please use this invitation to submit your bid(s) and attach supplemental pages as necessary. Bids will be received for services provided according to these instructions and specifications.

To be considered, this invitation to bid form must be completed in its entirety and **must be received no later than 5:00pm March 17, 2026**. The bids will be reviewed at the following Eureka County Fair Board Meeting.

The decision to accept a bid will depend on the quality of the bid, not necessarily on the lowest bid price. If your bid is accepted, your bid constitutes a binding contract and includes the specifications of this invitation to bid.

Bid Specifications:

1. Bid must contain a minimum of 20 broncs for Saddle Bronc Riding and a minimum of 10 bulls for the Bull Riding.
2. Bids may also contain one additional event such as, but not limited to Steer Stopping, Breakaway Roping, etc. Additional events will have to be approved by the Fair Board.
3. The submitted bid must include transportation of the horses and bulls to and from the fairgrounds.
4. The submitted bid must include the price for the entirety of the show. This includes announcer, entertainer, secretaries, etc.
5. The time frame provided for the Bull Riding and Saddle Bronc Show is from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on August 8, 2026. Please plan accordingly.
6. The horses and bulls must arrive at the Eureka County fairgrounds between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 8, 2026.
7. The horses and bulls must be removed from the Eureka County fairgrounds by 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 9, 2026.
8. All horses and bulls must be sound and healthy.
9. Bidder must provide their own staff to load and unload horses and bulls at the Eureka County fairgrounds.
10. Bidder must provide their own staff to handle the horses and bulls in the arena and chutes during the Bull Riding & Saddle Bronc event.
11. Bidder must provide their own staff to feed and water horses and bulls during their time at the Eureka County fairgrounds.
12. The Eureka County Fair will provide hay for the horses and bulls. The submitted bid must include how much hay the Bidder will require to feed the horses and bulls during their time at the Eureka County fairgrounds.
13. Eureka County Fair will not be providing room accommodations; this is the Bidder's responsibility.
